



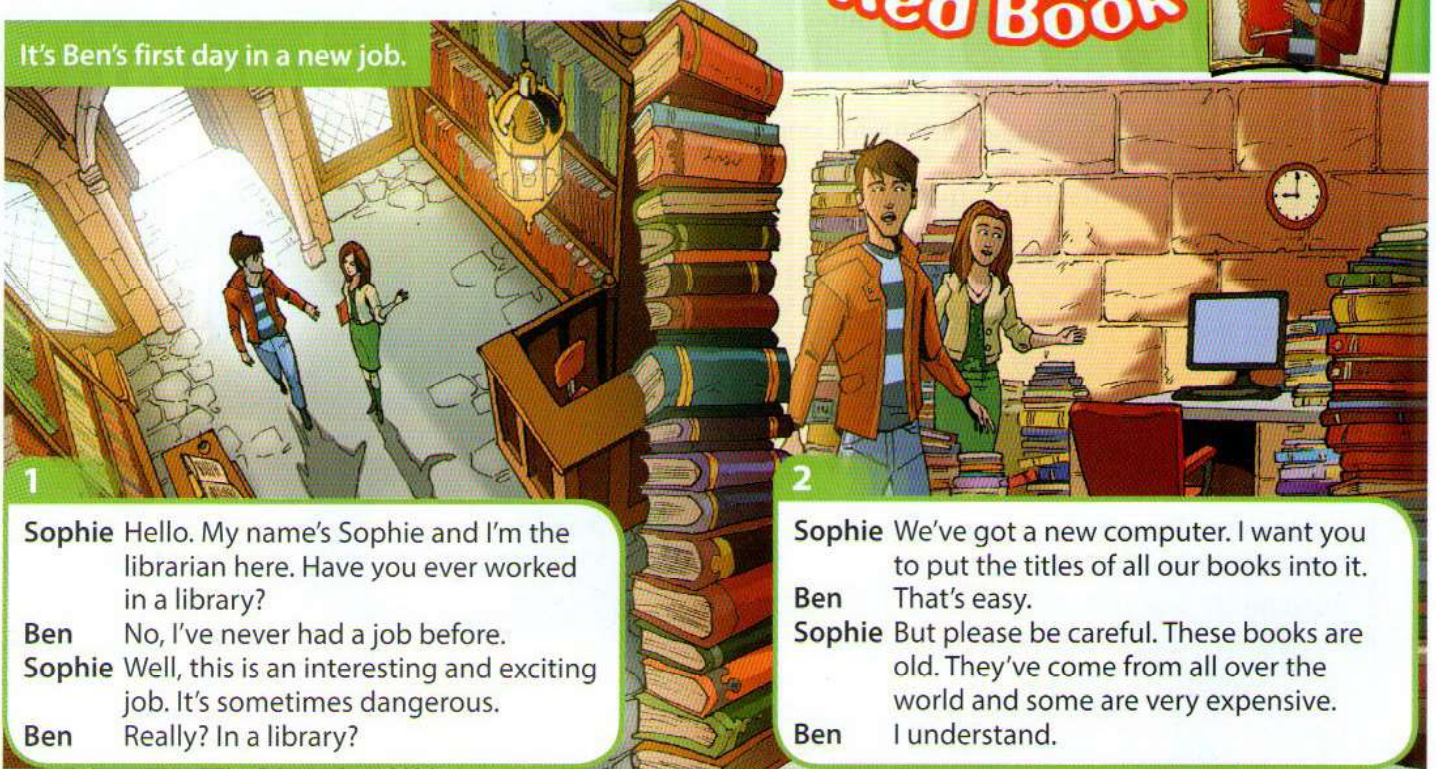

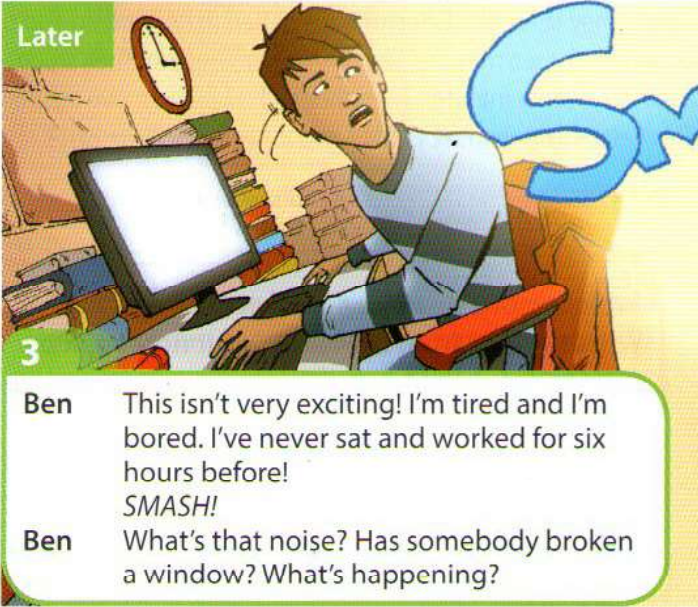


It's Ben's first day in a new job.

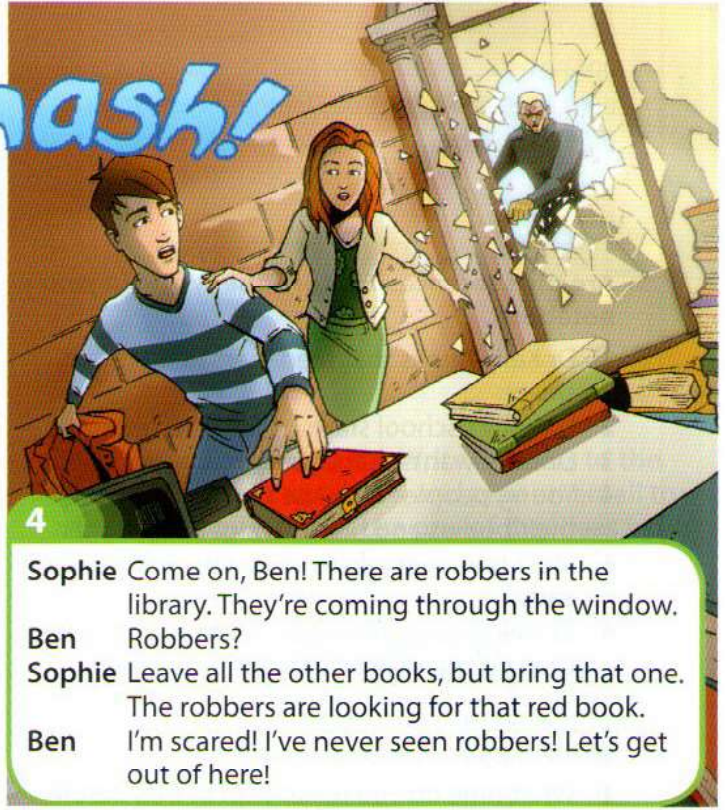
